**AGE GROUP RECOMMENDATION:** FYSA recommends that players not be registered to a team whose age group exceeds the player's age.

**EOSC REFUND POLICY**

A full refund will be issued if, and only if, EOSC is unable to place my child on an EOSC team. All requests to be withdrawn prior to the first game of the season must be made in writing. Refunds will be assessed a \$30.00 administrative fee. No refunds will be issued if a player withdraws after the first game of the season. Uniform costs will be refunded if the uniform is returned in original condition and has not been numbered or worn. **Additional fees associated with premier team registration, team transfers, dual registrations, training fees, tournaments, etc. are the sole responsibility of the parent. Premier players are assigned to their team for a period of one year, from August 1 - July 31. No refunds are given to premier players who choose to leave their team at any time during the seasonal year.**

- \*Give my best effort each day and remember that other players have strengths and weaknesses the same as I do.
- \*Exercise self-control, control my temper and resist the temptation to retaliate.
- \*Play by the rules, in accordance with FIFA's "Laws of the Game", and in adherence with FYSA rules.
- \*While traveling, conduct myself so as to bring credit to myself and my team.

**AND WILL NOT:**

- \*Possess, consume or distribute alcohol, illegal drugs, or unauthorized prescription drugs at, before or during any game.

**PARENTS/SPECTATORS WILL,** always, and at all times:

- \*Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, adult and youth officials and administrators.
- \*Place the emotional and physical well being of all players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- \*Support the actions and decisions of coaches, officials and administrators and to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- \*Remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults.
- \*Be positive or be quiet.
- \*Allow the coach to be the only coach.
- \*Treat other players, coaches, adult and youth officials, administrators, parents and spectators with dignity and respect.
- \*Ask my child to treat other players, coaches, adult and youth officials, administrators, parents and spectators with dignity and respect.

**AND WILL NOT:**

- \*Get into an argument with any parent, adult or youth official, player or coach.
- \*Come onto the field for any reason during a game.
- \*Criticize adult or youth officials.
- \*Possess, consume or distribute alcohol, illegal drugs or unauthorized prescription drugs at, before or during any game.

**COACHES/VOLUNTEERS WILL,** always, and at all times:

- \*Demonstrate knowledge of the sport; teach players the rules of the game and assist players to develop their skills.
- \*Be the primary soccer role model, and conduct myself in a positive manner.
- \*Lead by example, demonstrating fair play and good sportsmanship.
- \*Show respect for players, coaches, parents, spectators, and adult and youth officials and treat everyone with dignity.
- \*Motivate my players to give their best effort.

**AND WILL NOT:**

- \*Place the value of winning before the safety, welfare, and well being of all players.
- \*Act in a manner that undermines or jeopardizes the spirit of good sportsmanship nor use abusive or insulting language.
- \*Use profanity, make profane gestures, argue nor incite disruptive behavior by players, parents and/or spectators.
- \*Knowingly jeopardize the future eligibility of a player to participate in the sport.
- \*Tolerate inappropriate behavior, regardless of the situation.
- \*Criticize adult or youth officials.
- \*Allow the use of anabolic agents or stimulants, drugs, tobacco or alcohol by any of my players.
- \*Possess, consume or distribute alcohol, illegal drugs or unauthorized prescription drugs at, before or during any game.

**Failure to comply with this code of conduct may result in the suspension of my privilege to participate in East Orange Soccer Club and Florida Youth Soccer Association sanctioned events.**
